

Coed Glas PTA Rainbow Run Waiver

Signature required at time of checking in to acknowledge agreement

In order for your child to participate in the Coed Glas PTA Rainbow Run, you must confirm agreement with the following waiver prior to them taking part.

1. I am aged 18 years or above and wish for my child/children to participate in the Coed Glas PTA Rainbow Run on 19 June 2026 (or any date it is subsequently rearranged to). I am the parent/legal guardian of the registered child/children who is/are under the age of 18.
2. I agree that my child/children will participate in the Rainbow Run in accordance with the specific safety rules clearly explained by PTA volunteers or school staff at the beginning of the event.
3. I understand that participating in the Coed Glas PTA Rainbow Run is a potentially hazardous activity where coloured powder will be thrown at and around my child/children during the event. However, I understand that the powder is not harmful to people, animals or plant life.
4. I agree that my child will wear any safety equipment outlined by the Coed Glas PTA Rainbow Run. In accordance with the safety instructions and risk assessment, all participants must wear protective eyewear. This can include sunglasses, goggles, or prescription eyewear. Failure to comply with these instructions could result in the participation being denied.
5. Participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behaviour at all times and must always follow the instructions that are given to them. They must show respect towards the other pupils taking part, school staff, equipment and facilities and not misuse these in any way.
6. I confirm that my child is in good physical condition and has no medical impairments that may prevent them from participating in the activity.
7. I acknowledge that participation in the activity may be physically demanding and that there are risks of injury.
8. By giving my consent, I acknowledge that I have read, fully understood and agree with all of the above.
